WINTER STORM EMERGENCY DECLARATION

Effective date: Tuesday, March 6, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.
until Thursday, March 8, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.

All affected persons take notice:


Due to the forecast of potentially heavy snow accumulations, icy roads and high winds for our area, there exists a high risk of dangerous driving conditions, power outages and interruption of essential services such as phone, electric, water and emergency response. There will be a need to maintain passable roads for the provision of public and emergency services, and to maintain public health, safety and welfare.

Therefore, under the powers vested in me by the State of Pennsylvania and the New Britain Township Board of Supervisors as Emergency Management Coordinator, I, Eileen M. Bradley, declare that a Winter Storm Emergency exists in New Britain Township.

All persons are required to remove their parked vehicles from public streets. New Britain Township Police have the authority to ticket and/or tow vehicles in violation of this winter storm emergency declaration.

Residents and businesses are urged to shovel the snow accumulation from around fire hydrants and from sidewalks. No person may deposit snow in the public streets. Deposit snow away from the streets to protect everyone's safety.

If you do not have to travel, do not do so. If you travel, please drive with caution and at a slow speed appropriate to the conditions. Emergency vehicles and snow removal equipment have the right of way.
