BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES November 21, 2022

A Business Meeting of the New Britain Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday, November 21, 2022, at the Township Administration Building, 207 Park Avenue, New Britain Township, PA, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisors: Chair Gregory T. Hood, Vice-Chair William B. Jones, III, Members, Cynthia M. Jones, MaryBeth McCabe, Esq, and Stephanie Shortall. Also present were Township Manager Matt West, Assistant Manager Michael Walsh, Police Chief Richard Clowser, Township Engineer Craig Kennard, P.E., and Township Solicitor Sean Gresh.

1. Call to Order: Mr. Hood called the Meeting to order.

2. Pledge of Allegiance: Mr. Hood led the Board and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Chair Comments:

A. Executive Session:

Mr. Hood announced that the Board had met in Executive Session prior to the meeting to discuss personnel issues, land acquisition, and litigation.

4. Public Comment: There was no Public Comment at this time.

5. Presentation Items:

A. Turf Field at West Branch Park – PA Rush

Appearing on behalf of PA Rush was Robert Depman & Luka Okoniewski, to discuss PA Rush's proposal to convert the multi-purpose field at West Branch Park into a turf field and install lights. PA Rush proposed to pay for the installation and maintenance of the turf field. In exchange for expending the cost of the improvements, PA Rush would have the right of first refusal for use of the field. The Board took Public Comment on PA Rush's proposal.

Terence & Janet Dunn of Overlook Drive were opposed to PA Rush's proposal that would limit public use of a facility in a Township Park.

Ken Jones of Circle Drive and Margaret Briggs of Forest Park Drive had concerns about the environmental impact to the nearby watershed.

Margaret Briggs of Forest Park Drive asked about community involvement in PA Rush, the Township's potential return on investment, and if taxpayers would see any savings.

Michel Lockett of Hickory Lane supported PA Rush's proposal and felt it would bring more opportunities to play soccer on turf field for the youth of the New Britain Township.

PA Rush, the Board, Township Professionals, and the public discussed PA Rush's proposal. The Board stated they would need more information from PA Rush and asked staff to compile a list of questions for PA Rush to answer. PA Rush was asked to attend a future Board meeting, once they

had answers to the questions staff would be sending them following this evenings meeting. No action was taken at this time.

F. Motion to award Coleman property Demolition Bid

J. Motion to accept PCCD Grant and authorize signature of Award Notice

Chief Clowser stated the PCCD Grant was for purchasing and creating a policy for body worn cameras. The Board discussed the PCCD Grant.

MOTION: Upon motion by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mrs. Jones and unanimously carried, the Board accepted PCCD Subgrant Award Number 2021-BW-01-37745 and authorize the Board Chair Gregory T. Hood to sign the PCCD Grant Award Notice, per the attachments.

K. Motion to adopt updated Employee Manual, effective January 1, 2023.
