Proposed Native Tree and Shrub Planting on Conservation Easement, Mill Ridge Dr.

- Homeowner would like to pursue, once endorsed by the HOA, a restoration project on 2.5 acres of township conserved land.
 - Project would plant (budget and volunteer dependent) 200-250 trees/shrubs
 - Annual area mowing would maintain herbaceous groundcover
 - A more frequently mowed walking trail, possibly mulched, would provide passive recreational access.

- Homeowners have consulted with BCCD for site suitability and planting approach for the area.
 - BCCD encourages tree canopy restoration on this site and wherever practical – shading, water cycling, habitat.
 - Site has diverse groundcover species with mostly native tree/shrubs at the tree lines.
 - BCCD facilitates the PA Horticultural Society's Trees for Watersheds grant and feels this project is suitable, with either a non-profit organization, or BCCD as applicant.

- Homeowners have investigated costs of maintenance of the planted area, including regular watering of the trees, and have agreed to assume costs/cost-share with HOA.

- Homeowners seek concurrence from township that native tree and shrub plantings on the parcel is a net benefit to the township should be considered an allowable activity for conservation easements.

- BCCD asks supervisors to consider endorsement of this type of collaboration as a mostly passive contribution to Neshaminy watershed management.

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CONSERVATION EASEMENT

12. Declarant hereby creates and imposes, upon and across the Property, Conservation Easements prohibiting the filling, removal, destruction, or other disturbance of the conservation easement areas denoted on the Plan and more particularly described by the legal descriptions attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit "B"**.

13. These Conservation Easements are created for the benefit of and hereby granted to New Britain Township. The purpose of the Conservation Easements is to maintain the conservation easement areas in their natural condition and to protect these easement areas from soil erosion, water pollution, and any other disruptions or occurrences that might interfere with the natural, scenic, and/or open space state of the easement areas. The placement or construction of any buildings, structures, or other improvements, including, but not limited to signs, fences, patios, driveways, roads, or parking lots, is prohibited within these Easements without the express, prior, written approval of New Britain Township to such placement/construction, and no excavation, depositing, dumping, filling, dredging, cultivation or other disturbance of the soil, or other intrusions shall occur within the conservation easement areas.

14. Declarant hereby covenants and agrees to service and maintain the conservation easement areas in good condition and repair. Declarant shall keep the conservation easement areas free and clear of all trash, debris, and other material that may enter these easement areas and shall be prohibited from storing any materials of any kind within these easement areas.

**BUDGET WORKSHOP #1
MEETING MINUTES
September 17, 2024**

The Board of Supervisors Budget Workshop #1 Meeting of New Britain Township was held on Tuesday, September 17, 2024, at the Township Building, 207 Park Avenue, Chalfont, PA beginning at 8:30am.

Present were Supervisors: Cynthia M. Jones- Chair, MaryBeth McCabe – Vice-Chair, Bill Jones, Stephanie Shortall, and Bridget Kunakorn. Also present were Dan Fox - Township Manager, Chief Richard Clowser, Ryan Cressman – Public Works Superintendent, Bill May – Park & Recreation Supervisor, Kristin Carpenter – Director of Finance, and Alexandria Mullin - Executive Administrative Assistant.

1. **Call to Order:** Cynthia Jones called the meeting to order at 8:30 am.
2. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Cynthia Jones led the Board and public in the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. **Chair Comments** Cynthia Jones stated that the Board met in Executive session, prior to this meeting, to discuss personnel matters and litigation items.
4. **Information Items**
 - A. Township Manager- Budget Overview

Dan Fox described the new 2025 Budget process and how the Township would like to handle budget processes moving forward including formatting and structure. He explained that each department head will have an opportunity to discuss their needs and capital requests. He further explained how the Township will reflect those expenditures within the budget and how the funds will be managed.

B. Departmental Requests

Chief Clowser went through his department expenditures and discussed what the Police Department will be spending money on and what they expect to be high-cost items. The Chief then explained each item on his Capital Plan request form and why these requests would be important to the department.

Bill May described the expenditures for the Park & Recreation department which were almost identical to those from last year. He doesn't anticipate any major changes and that is reflected in his yearly budget. He then went on to explain the items within his Capital Plan request form and why these projects/items would be essential to the Park & Recreation department.

Ryan Cressman went through his department expenditures and discussed what the Public Works department will be spending money on and what they expect to be high-cost items. Ryan then explained each item on his Capital Plan request form and why these requests would be important to the department.

A discussion ensued regarding the Townships need for curb repair and whether this should fall on the residents or the Township for maintenance. The Board of Supervisors voted to have the responsibility of curb repair fall solely on the homeowner. In 2025, each homeowner will be notified of the curb repairs needed for their home prior to a road paving project beginning but the responsibility of making those repairs falls to the homeowner.

Dan Fox described the needs of the administration department and how some of the line items have been reformatted to be clearer. He went on to explain the Capital plan needs of the department and how each request would benefit the Township.

C. Township Manager – Expenditures / Capital Overview

Dan Fox explained how at the end of September the Township will be able to provide more accurate expenditures and then be able to provide a more accurate representation of revenue.

MaryBeth McCabe discussed the recent change with EMS funds and how she would like to see the Township address this and make sure we are properly funding our Emergency Services.
